ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for construction of the Oak Creek Water Plant Expansion, addressed to the Oak Creek Water and Sewer Building, 170 W. Drexel Ave., Oak Creek, WI 53154, will be received at the office of the Oak Creek Water and Sewer Utility, (Owner), until 2:00 p.m., local time, on the 2nd day of December 2008. Any Bids received after the specified time will not be considered.

Bids will then be publicly opened and read.

The Project contemplated consists of:

Schedule A:

- Expansion of the pretreatment building with two new concrete flocculation and plate settling basins, one new chemical storage room, and one new electrical room.
- Expansion of the filter building with four new filters and one new hallway.
- Associated yard piping, building piping, sitework, instrumentation and controls, electrical, heating ventilation, air conditioning, plumbing, and security systems.

Schedule B:

- Construction of a new 300,000-gallon elevated steel backwash supply tank including cathodic protection system and associated foundation, piping, electrical, coatings, and control systems.
- Limits of construction shall be the foundation, elevated tank and coatings, and backwash supply piping five (5) feet away from the elevated tank foundation.

Schedule C:

- Removal and disposal of filter media, gravel and underdrains in Filters 1 through 6.
- Furnish and install new filter media and underdrains in Filters 1 through 6.

The Work will be completed in all respects within the number of calendar days from the date the Contract commences to run, as set forth below:

Schedule A 500 calendar days

Schedule B 590 calendar days

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Schedule C 500 calendar days

All schedules will be awarded under one contract.

Return of the documents is not required, and the amount paid for the documents is nonrefundable.
