MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS <u>Professional Services Agreement-I94/Ryan Road Water Main</u> Crossing:

Commissioner Richards, with Commissioner Wille seconding, made the motion to authorize the Utility Engineer to enter into an agreement with City Water LLC for providing professional services in the design of the I-94/Ryan Road Water Main Crossing project in the not to exceed amount of \$40,000.00 and to amend the capital budget by the same amount. Roll call vote, all voted aye.

<u>Purchase Replacement Raw Water Pump Motor:</u> Commissioner Richards, with Commissioner Siira seconding, made the motion to approve the recommended bid from L&S Electrical Inc. for the replacement of the raw water #7 electric motor in the amount of \$13,720.00. Roll call vote, all voted aye.
